SNAP (Formerly Food Stamps)

What is it? SNAP (the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program—formerly Food Stamps) is the cornerstone of all federal nutrition assistance programs, providing benefits for the purchase of nutritious food to qualified low-income people in addition to economic benefits for the local community.

Do I qualify? Eligibility is based on income and resources available to the household. You may receive SNAP benefits even if you do not receive cash assistance. SNAP benefits are not welfare.

Women, Infants and Children (WIC)

What is it? WIC provides nutritious foods for eligible Women, Infants, and Children.

What does it provide? Participants receive vouchers for nutritious foods including fruits, vegetables, milk, eggs, peanut butter, cheese, juice, cereal, infant formula and baby food. Additional vouchers for fresh produce in summer and fall are also provided.

Do I qualify? WIC is available to eligible pregnant women, nursing and bottle-feeding mothers, and infants and children up to the age of 5 years in families with incomes up to 185%. Expected babies are counted in family size.

The School Lunch and Breakfast Programs

What are they? The School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs are federal programs that provide nutritious meals to children as a regular part of their school day.

Do I qualify? Meals are free if your income is under 130% poverty or reduced-price if you are under 185% of poverty. Parents must submit an application form to receive reduced price or free meals.
